2018 Joint FAO/WHO Meeting on Pesticide Residues (JMPR)

I have the pleasure to invite you to participate in this year's Session of the Joint FAO/WHO Meeting on Pesticide Residues (JMPR) which is organized in collaboration with the Federal Institute for Risk Assessment (BfR). The meeting will take place from 18 to 27 September 2018 while the pre-meeting from 13 to 17 September 2018. Both meetings will be held in the BfR's branch located in Berlin-Marienfelde.

The experts attend the JMPR as independent, internationally recognized specialists who act in their personal capacity and not as representatives of their government.
